







The Bank Hotel Istanbul

The Bank Hotel Istanbul, has a deep-rooted history and is also an example of eclectic architecture.

The building, which dates back to the 1860s, used to host the Crédit Général Ottoman, Deutsche Bank and Sümerbank. The historical texture in this building has been preserved with the unique restoration based on the principle "to renew by keeping its original shape and protecting its artistic value"

The Bank Hotel Istanbul is situated on Banks Street, formerly known as Voyvoda Street, which used to be the center of goldsmiths and bankers. The historical peninsula (Istanbul's Old City), where all the historical

monuments and the most important museums are located, is a walking distance to The Sultan Ahmet Mosque.
